July 6 th 2017	Community Councillors John Kennedy and Graham Edmunds	<p>From 2. Declarations of Interest page 2121: <i>Councillor John Kennedy declared an interest for Agenda item 8, Planning, as regards DC/2017/00136, The Old Mill House at Rockfield, as he is a neighbour to the property in question.</i> <i>Councillor Graham Edmunds also declared an interest for Agenda item 8. This being as regards DC/2017/00552, the Bell at Skenfrith, as he lives within close proximity to the marquees.</i> Also, from 8. Planning Matters, page 2123: DC/2017/00136 Old Mill House, Rockfield. <i>Councillor John Kennedy left the room while this was discussed.</i></p> <p>And: DC/2017/00552 <i>retention of marquees at The Bell, Skenfrith, between April and October. It was agreed that Councillor Graham Edmunds would take no part in any discussions or Council business as regards this application. Preliminary discussions took place about the application, having regards to the comments made at item 5. It was agreed that Councillors Desmond Pugh, Steve Morgan and Len Lane (in place of Graham Edmunds) would examine the case further and make recommendations at a later date.</i></p>
September 7 th 2017	Community Councillors George Edwards and Robin Wintour	<p>From 2. Declarations of interest, page 2126: <i>It was noted that prior to the meeting, interests had been declared regarding Planning application DC/2017/00898, Red House Farm. This being owned by Councillor George Edwards. Councillor Robin Wintour declared an interest in being a friend of the applicant.</i> <i>No further declarations of interest were received as regards the published Agenda. Councillors agreed to identify any that arose during the course of the meeting.</i></p> <p>Also, from 8. Planning Matters, page 2128:</p>

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		<p><i>DC/2017/00898, 7th August - adding a steel frame lean-to onto an existing agricultural building, Red House Farm, Rockfield, NP25 5NH. Interests had been declared as the application had been submitted by Councillor George Edwards, and Councillor Robin Wintour as a friend of the applicant. (Councillors would usually examine applications made within their own wards). A comment recommending approval had been placed on the Planning Portal following an examination of the proposal by Councillors Yvonne Rees and Steve Morgan.</i></p>
October 5 th 2017	Community Councillor Yvonne Price	<p>From 2. Declarations of interest, page 2132: <i>Councillor Yvonne Price declared an interest as regards planning application DC/2017/01129. Councillors agreed to identify any further conflicts of interest that arose during the course of the meeting.</i></p> <p>Also, from 8. Planning Matters, page 2134: <i>DC/2017/01129 change of use from field to garden, erection of small shed to house historic vehicles. Ty Gwyn, NP25 5NP. Councillor Yvonne Price having declared an interest in being married to the applicant, she had taken no part in evaluating the proposal. The site and application were examined by two Councillors from another ward and a comment supporting the application had been placed on the planning portal.</i></p>
November 2 nd 2017	Community Councillor Graham Edmunds	<p>From 8. Planning Matters, page 2139: <i>DC/2017/00552 The Bell, Skenfrith, erection of marquees. Councillor Graham Edmunds declared a continuing interest as having submitted objections on his own behalf, as a resident overlooking the proposed development; i.e. not as a Councillor. Following previous delays, MCC had informed the Clerk that the application would go before the Planning Committee on Tuesday, 7th November.</i></p>

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December 14 th 2017	Community Councillor Ray Bowen	<i>From 8. Planning Matters, page 2144: DC/2017/01269, 23rd November. Holly Barn, Newcastle, NP25 5NU. Change of use from Agricultural to Agriculture & Equestrian. To include construction of a timber field shelter and a 20x40 Metre ménage. Councillor Ray Bowen declared an interest in being a neighbour to the property in question. The Clerk was informed that the notice had been placed on Boot Barn by error, and emailed MCC on the 30th requesting that this be corrected, and also to reset the 21 day period.</i>
